Established in 1949, Avgoulea-Linardatou School is a private educational institution located in Peristeri, in the western suburbs of Athens, Greece. Since its genesis, the school has retained a focus on fostering the individual creativity of each student, aiming to nurture their self-esteem and confidence. It seeks to deploy teaching methods that make it less of an effort for students to acquire and retain knowledge.

Today, Avgoulea-Linardatou School employs 360 teachers and administrators, and currently consists of 1,600 students. It includes a kindergarten, elementary school, middle school and high school, and offers a wide range of extracurricular activities including sports, arts, volunteering, and cultural initiatives.

Avgoulea-Linardatou School aims to prepare its students for successful and happy lives, which means keeping both educational content and delivery methods up to date. The organization has its sights set high: aiming to design the school of the future.

To achieve this ambition, Avgoulea-Linardatou School looks to harness the latest digital technologies to create innovative learning environments that inspire and engage students. The school recognized that the most effective methods of educational delivery are highly tailored, and so sought to gain a better understanding of individual student progress and different learning styles.



Resonating with the undisputed fact that learning is not restricted to the classroom, Avgoulea-Linardatou School wanted to provide students with access to inspiring content both inside and outside the classroom. And when the COVID-19 pandemic forced the closure of schools across Greece, the organization knew it was time to kickstart its latest digital transformation plans.

Empowering students and **teachers**

First, Avgoulea-Linardatou School focused on rolling out distance learning for all subjects and year groups from kindergarten through to K-12. Teachers delivered online classes and interacted with students via video call in real-time, with the content also being available asynchronously. Students were able to take virtual trips to places including Niagara Falls and the North Carolina Science Museum.

Next, Avgoulea-Linardatou School adopted a one-to-one learning model, which involved providing each student with a Lenovo ThinkPad 11e laptop with an active stylus. The school initially purchased 135 devices and began the roll-out with the first grade of its middle school.

The ThinkPad 11e laptops are purpose-built for educational use, with apps for notetaking, annotating PDFs, deeper comprehension, interactive exercises, and more.

The Lenovo laptops are designed to be highly robust, with a rubber bumper to absorb the force of any rough handling. Moreover, the laptops have been tested to military specifications, demonstrating that they can cope with a variety of environmental factors such as high and low pressure, humidity, vibration, high and low temperatures, solar radiation, fungus, and dust. Avgoulea-Linardatou School also opted for a three-year warranty with damage support from Lenovo. As a result, the school can expect the laptops to last their students.

Using built-in LanSchool software, Avgoulea-Linardatou School can monitor and manage student activity from a central point of control. It can also promote collaboration in the classroom with advanced screen-sharing and messaging features.


Results
